



PolyRAIL[®] Product Cleaning Instructions

Thank you for purchasing one of our vinyl products. Although it is maintenance free, at some point in time you may wish to clean it. Below are a few suggestions for cleaning your PolyRAIL[®] product.

Standard Cleaning: Our PolyRAIL[®] Railing can be cleaned with any kind of cleaning product that is recommended for vinyl (Softscrub[®], 409[®], etc.)

Stains: If there is a stain that will not clean off with a regular vinyl cleaning product, you can use lacquer thinner. This needs to be applied to a rag first, then wipe the rag across the vinyl product. **DO NOT POUR THE LACQUER THINNER OR LAY THE RAG ON THE VINYL.** This may cause damage to the vinyl. A power washer also does a nice job of cleaning your vinyl product.

Spray On/Off Cleaners: If you want to spray on a cleaner and then spray off, a product by the name of SuperClean (made by Castrol[®]) can be used. It needs to be diluted with water and then sprayed on. This can be left on for a short period of time and then will need to be rinsed off with water. This will take off some light stains. This particular product can be purchased at WalMart (in the automotive department) or in some hardware or automotive stores.

Tar Stains: In cases where tar needs to be removed, Goof-Off may be used.
